Over 11,000 students used the Warrior Food Pantry this Fall semester equaling up to 100,000 lbs. of food. The clothing closet gave out nearly 2,000 articles of clothing. There is no limit to articles of clothing a student can choose as it is based on need. Campus cares has also handed out over 100,000 dollars' worth of emergency grants, housing placements, and meal cards to students in need. CalFresh Food/Outreach is a supplemental nutritional food assistance program and has an 85-90% approval rate.
