# **Candidates FAQs Sheet**

### **How does one join ASI Student Government?**

You can run for the ASI Board of Directors position during Spring Elections. Please visit the <u>ASI Student Government Elections</u> page for more information.

#### **How long is the term for ASI Board of Directors positions?**

ASI Board of Director positions have a 1-year term; start of term is June 1<sup>st</sup>. You may run again once elections are held annually.

#### What are the qualifications to apply to run for an ASI Board of Director seat?

The students should be involved in/have interest in the seat seeking to run for.

Undergraduate and/or Graduate Candidates refer to the <u>ASI Elections Code</u>, Section 4.0, for unit and GPA requirements.

#### What are the qualifications to apply to run for an ASI Executive position?

Undergraduate and/or Graduate Candidates refer to the <u>ASI Elections Code</u>, Section 4.0, for unit and GPA requirements. To be able to run for an ASI Executive position (President, Vice President, or Vice President of Finance) you must have served one semester as a member of the ASI Board of Directors.

If a candidate does not meet the qualification of having one semester served on the ASI Board of Directors, candidate may appeal to the Elections Committee.

## What is the appealing process to apply for an ASI Executive position?

Students interested in applying and running to be an ASI Executive candidate but does not meet the minimum qualifications of having one semester served on the ASI Board of Directors, the candidate may appeal to the ASI Elections Commission by submitting an appeal letter.

In this appeal letter, the student will explain why they feel they are qualified to run for this specific position and explain their knowledge revolving the topics below:

- Knowledge of Associated Students, Inc.
- Knowledge of current events in regards to higher education
- Political system and Administration at Stanislaus State
- Campus current events

All appeals must be submitted, heard, and decided upon at least seven (7) calendar days before mandatory candidates meeting. The deadline to submit this appeal letter this year is Tuesday, March  $5^{th}$ , 2024.
