**Resolution Addressing Dissatisfaction Among Students with
on Campus Parking**


1. **WHEREAS:** The Associated Students, Inc., is the representative body and the official voice of the students at California State University, Stanislaus; and
2. **WHEREAS:** The high cost of student parking passes as well as the limited and often inconvenient locations designated to student parking, have long been a complaint of many students, particularly when compared to the parking costs paid by and the designated parking locations made available to faculty and staff; and
3. **WHEREAS:** In addressing the continual concerns voiced by students, there are several areas where improvements can be made; and as such
4. **BE IT RESOLVED:** To improve the effectiveness of the Parking Task Force Committee, by:
 - Defining the structure of this committee,
 - Determining and making a list of those people/positions most necessary to be part of this committee,
 - Increase the number of student representatives who serve on this committee from one student to three student representatives,
 - Defining the specific charge of this committee, and
 - Meeting at least quarterly to address parking related concerns, including budget, fines, projects, shuttle program, and all parking guidelines.
5. **FUTHER RESOLVED:** To expand the operating hours of the free campus shuttle, *Warrior Express*, from its current evening-only schedule to an all-day service; and
6. **FURTHER RESOLVED:** To support revision of Section XIII. *Parking Accommodation Request of University PD's Parking Guidelines* to read:

Campus departments hosting non-campus events are not eligible for a parking fee exemption. These events are outside the primary scope and ~~educational~~ mission of the University.


Removing “educational” from Section XIII allows Associated Students, Inc., the University Student Center, and student organizations to be eligible for a parking fee exemption.

7. **FURTHER RESOLVED:** To eliminate all Faculty/Staff (employee only) parking areas, allowing open parking for anyone with regular semester or annual permits (not including economy parking permits).
8. **FINALLY RESOLVED:** That a copy of this Resolution be sent to Rose McAuliffe, Vice President of Business and Finance/ CFO; Clint Strode, Chief of Police; Christine Erickson, Vice President of Student Affairs; Heather Dunn Carlton, AVP/ Dean of Students.
