Resolution Supporting and Approving a Student Fee Increase for ASI of \$15.00 (Fifteen Dollars) Per Semester

WHEREAS, the Associated Students, Inc., is the representative body and the official voice of the students at California State University, Stanislaus; and

WHEREAS, although education and graduation are the primary goals of all students, the total college experience can and should include a vast array of experiences and opportunities inside and outside of the classroom; and

WHEREAS, extracurricular experiences greatly enhance a student's overall college experience and serve to prepare students for their future in ways that are different from but complementary to their studies; and

WHEREAS, student fees fund a variety of Student Life and Student Success programs and services, all which provide opportunities to learn and grow outside of the classroom; and

WHEREAS, decreasing enrollment numbers and the resulting reduction in revenue from student fees negatively impact the quality and quantity of activities and services ASI can provide to our students; and

WHEREAS, our current vision is not simply to maintain the status quo, but to enhance and expand the services, events, and activities we provide to all students, with a specific focus on our student organizations and student athletes.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that to maintain and enhance the current level of events, activities and services provided to our students, the Associated Students, Inc., of California State University, Stanislaus, recommend and approve a \$15.00 student fee increase per semester.
