## Resolution Recommending the Establishment of a University Hour (U-Hour) at California State University, Stanislaus

**1. WHEREAS:** The Associated Students, Inc., (ASI) is the representative body and the official

voice of the students at California State University, Stanislaus; and

2. WHEREAS: We believe the most satisfying and extraordinary college experiences are only

realized when students are encouraged and able to become involved in a variety of opportunities the campus has to offer, including events and celebrations,

student life activities and community networking and department gatherings; and

**3. WHEREAS:** A *U-Hour* encourages this type of student, faculty and staff engagement by

setting aside time periods when no lecture classes are scheduled and lab scheduling is kept to a minimum, thereby allowing the campus community

to partake in various campus activities: and

**4. WHEREAS**: A significant benefit of a *U-Hour* would be the sense of campus community and

a sense of belonging, particularly for those students who may otherwise feel

'disconnected' from their peers; and

**5. WHEREAS:** Additional benefits of a U-Hour would be:

- A greater focus on campus pride,
- Opportunities for campus wide celebrations and events allowing all campus members to attend,
- Fostering a deeper connection for students and faculty to engage with campus, in other than the classroom setting, and
- Enhancing a vibrant learning environment by encouraging participation in out-of-classroom activities and experiences.

## **6. WE THEREFORE RECOMMEND:**

Establishing a U-Hour on our campus, to be held one day a week, during normal school calendar weeks, taking place each Tuesday and Thursday from 11:00am to 12:00pm.

- **7. RESOLVED**: The ASI Board of Directors enthusiastically supports and endorses the establishment of a U-Hour as outlined above.
