-Marvin asked is it more important to advertise programming or services

-She states students are able to see programming by walking by the Student Center

-Cassandra states she agrees, programming shows itself, but services do not, if students come into the building for programming, then we could show them services

-Marvin asked, as a student would it annoy you to get a bunch of emails from Student Center everyday about services and programming

-Gianna states no it would not be annoying, if it is clear and consistent -Adela states if it is visual appealing and straight to the point would be better than a longworded email

-Donovan states the frequency matters, once or twice a semester wouldn't be too much, but something that could be in one email but instead is in multiple emails can be too much -Elizabeth states students home lives are always changing, and just to have that reminder helps them remember what is available for them

-Melannie states in efforts of getting students to the building besides the organization is allowing other organizations to rent the rooms, they haven't tried contacting them directly

-She states it could be a potential thing to reach out, but they haven't

-Cesar states prior to COVID they had 31 events scheduled before the building was even open -He states it is defiently there but due to the closure those events were cancelled

-Donovan states he would like to add is to have more connection between the Turlock and Stockton Campus, so students do not feel so divided

-He states mimicking what services Turlock Campus offers and then Stockton Campus
