

Non-Discrimination Policy

PURPOSE

This policy is in effect to ensure that ASI and USU provide a welcoming environment and give everyone an equal opportunity.

POLICY


The University Student Union and the Associated Students, Incorporated of California State University, Stanislaus do not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, physical disability or sexual orientation in the events, programs, or other activities it conducts.

PROCEDURE

- 1.0 The University Student Union and the Associated Students, Incorporated, are committed to providing equal opportunities to men and women in all events and programs provided or sponsored by the University Student Union and the Associated Students, Incorporated.
- 2.0 The University Student Union and the Associated Students, Incorporated prohibit discrimination of current or potential students and employees with Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV). They shall be afforded unrestricted working conditions, use of USU and ASI facilities and participation in USU and ASI events and programs as long as they are physically and psychologically able to do so.
- 3.0 No person shall, on the grounds of race, color, or national origin be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity sponsored by the University Student Union.
- 4.0 Complaints should be addressed to the USU and ASI Director. Retaliation on the basis of a complaint is prohibited and all inquiries will be confidential to the extent permitted by law.
